

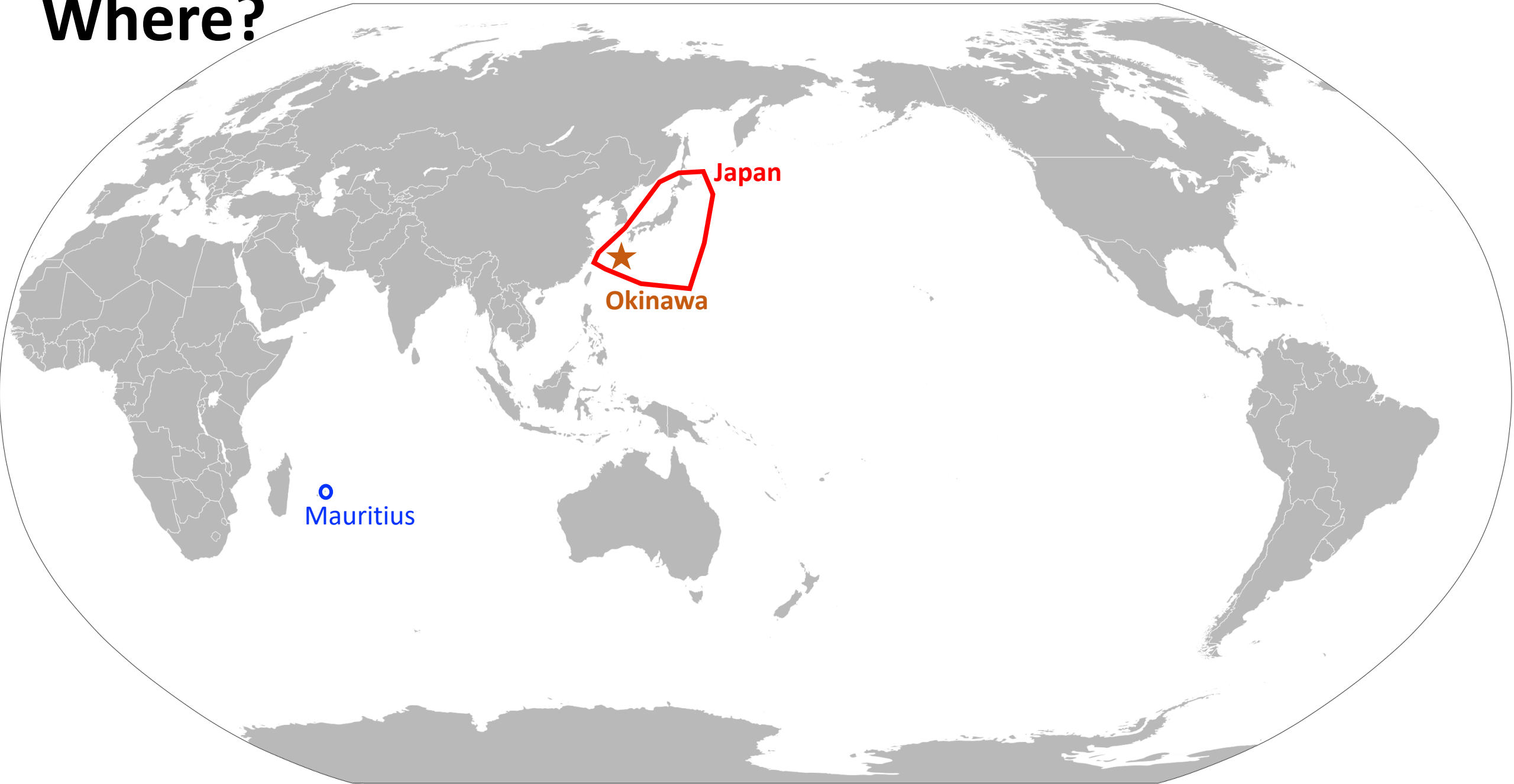

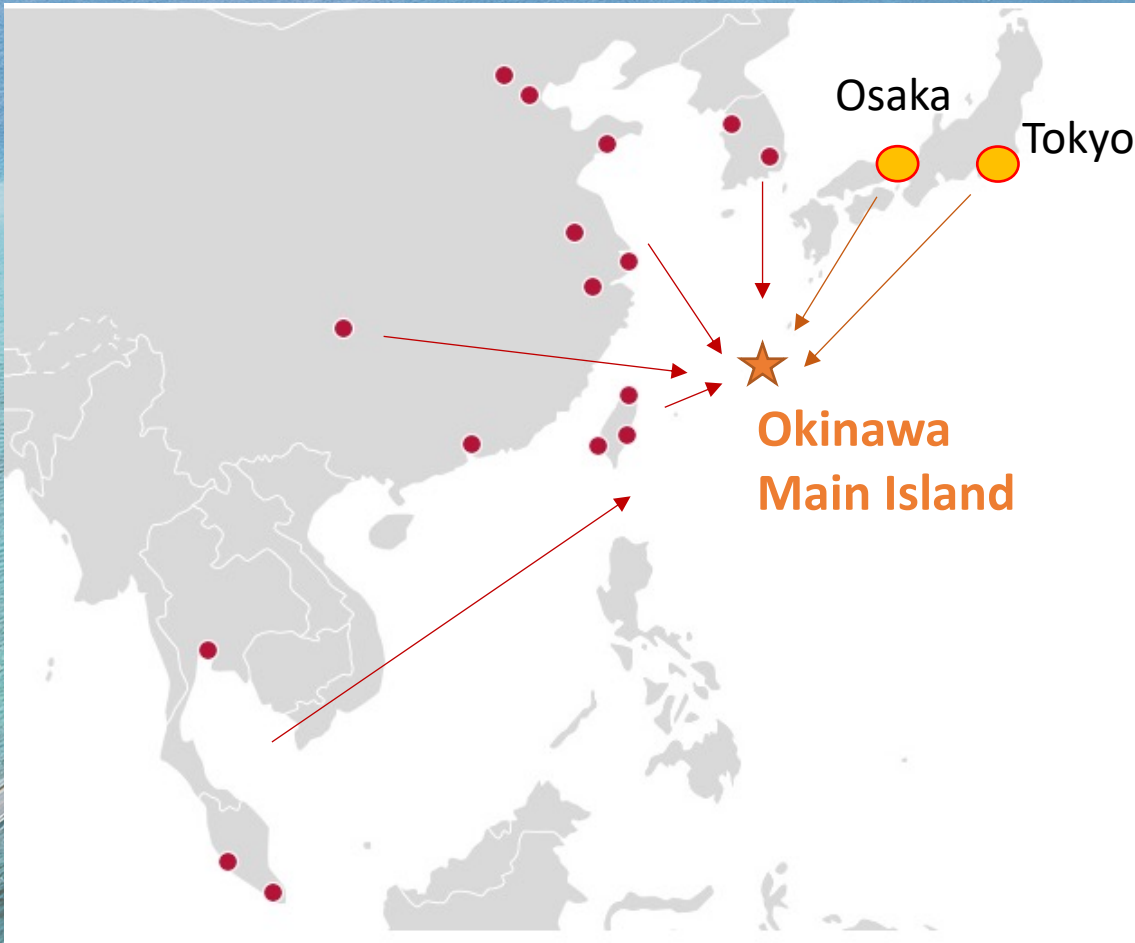

Flight Access to Okinawa Main Island

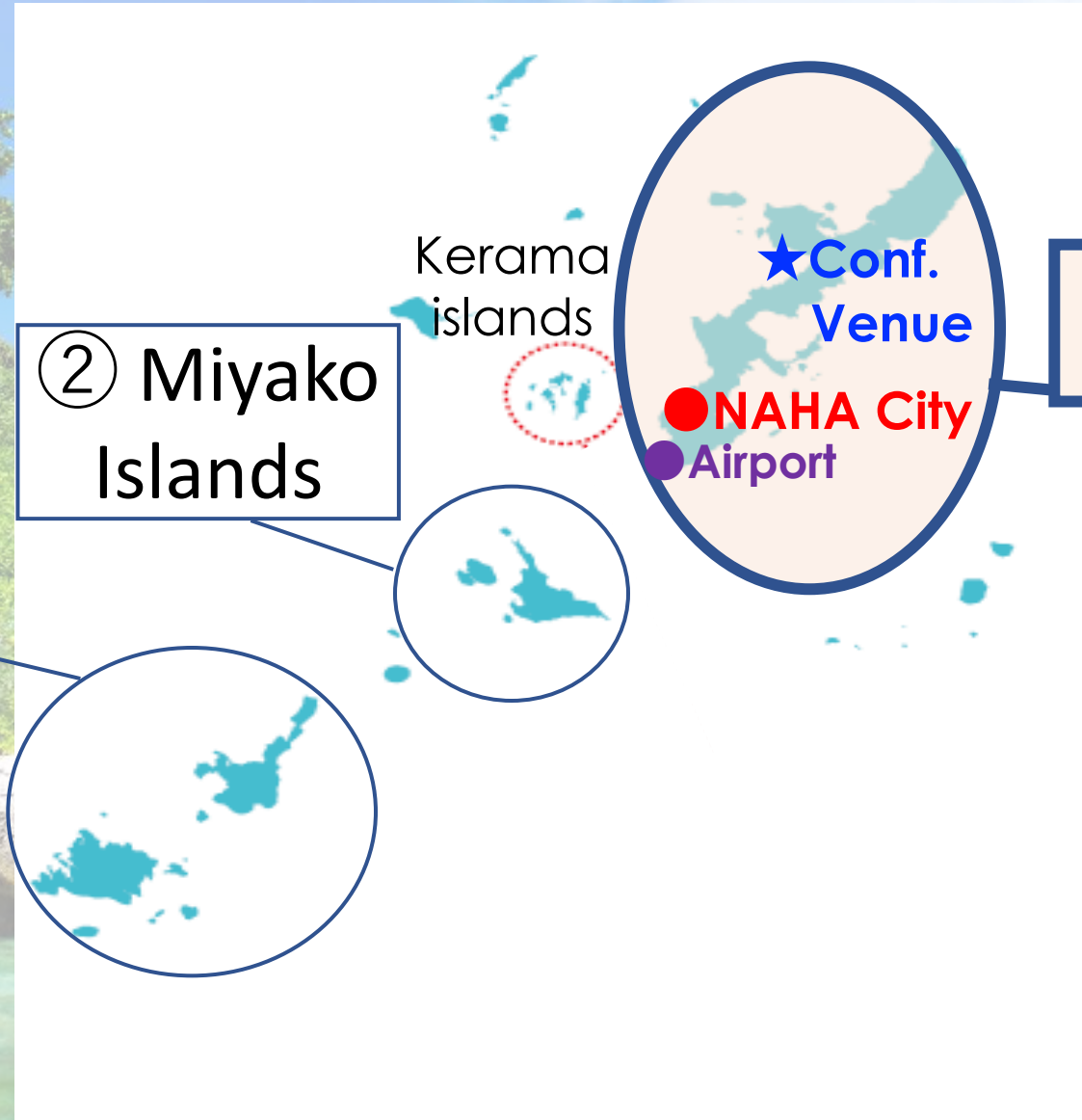

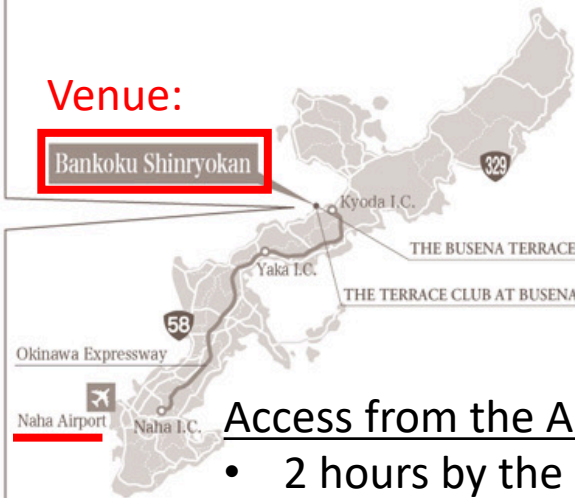
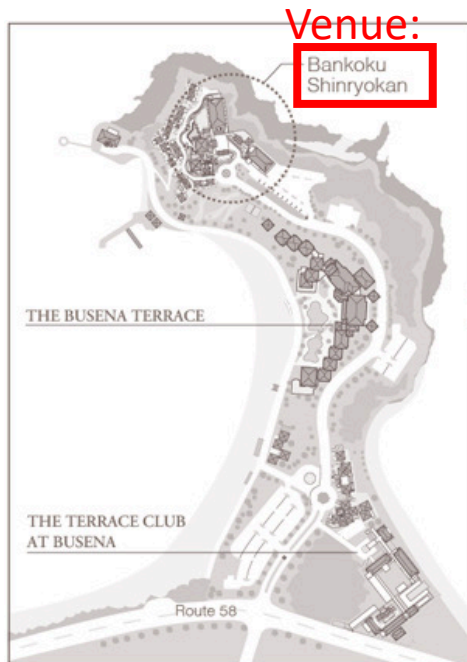


Conference Venue

Access from the Airport:

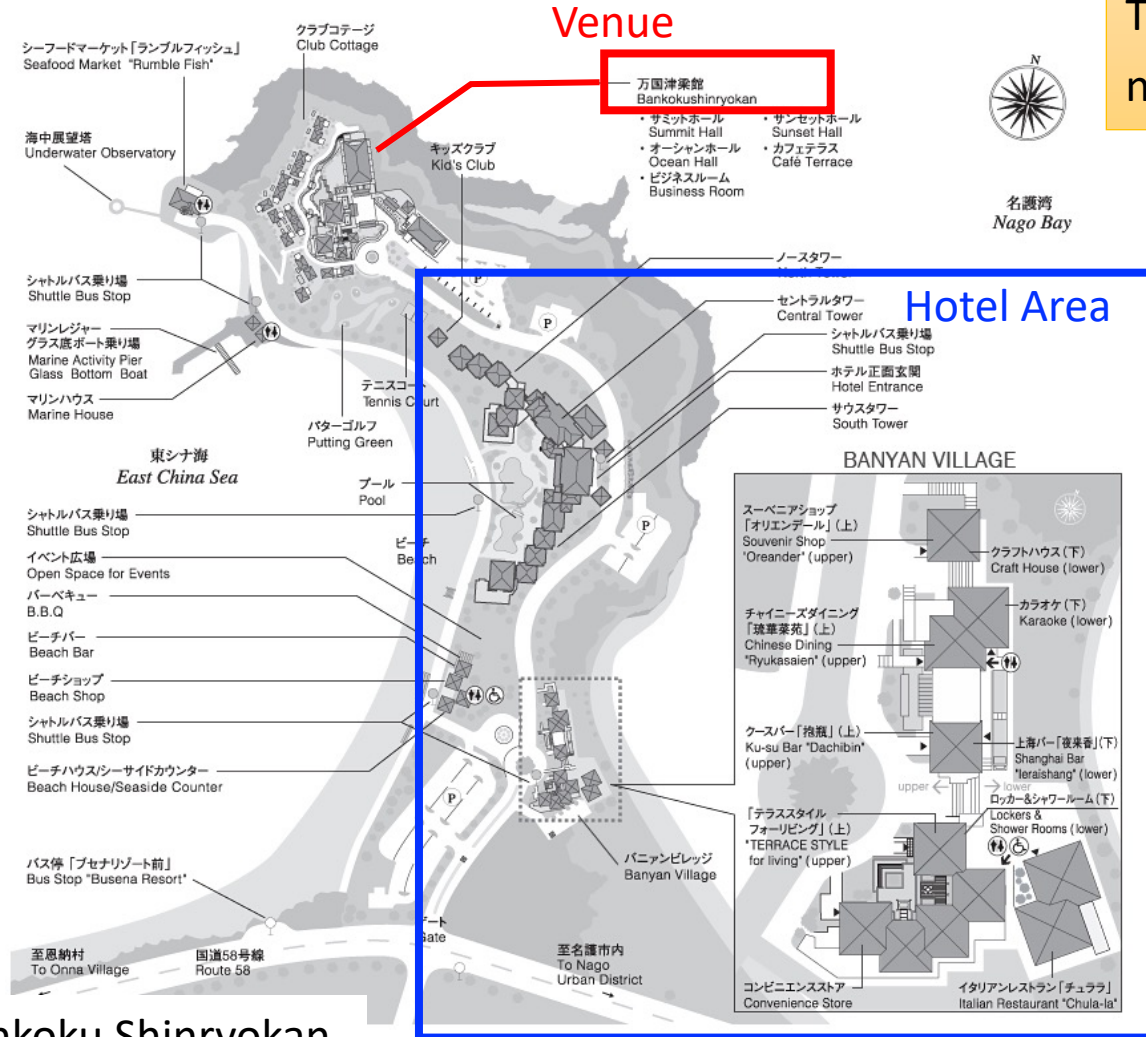
- 2 hours by the shuttle bus

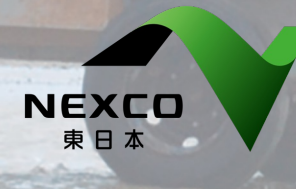

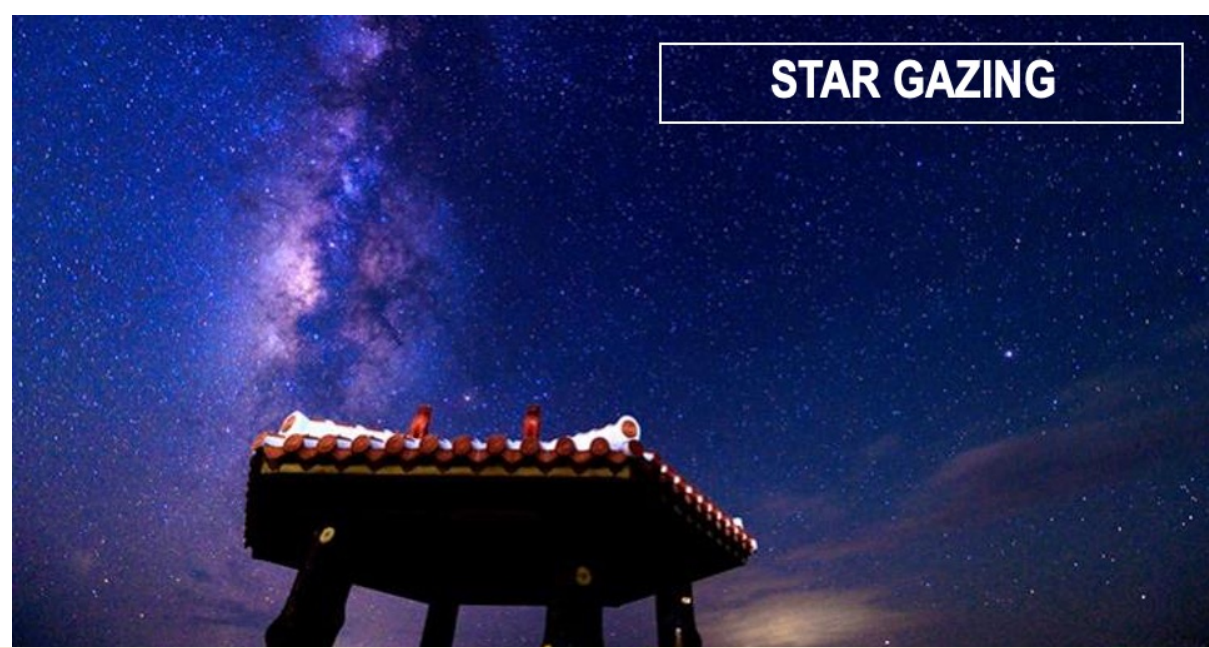
